What happens in Year Four this term?

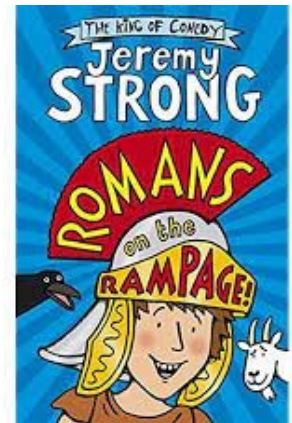

Spring 1 Topic

I am Warrior

This term, our topic has a **History** focus, with children learning all about The Romans. The children will learn about how and why the Roman Empire invaded Britain and what life was like in the Roman Empire, explaining the legacy it left behind.

In **English**, we will be reading 'Romans on the Rampage' by Jeremy Strong, This comical, historical fiction book centers on a family and their dilemmas. The children will develop many reading skills and there are strong links to history. We will also spend some time looking at non-fiction texts about the Romans and our writing will have a non-fiction focus.

In **Mathematics**, we will continue our work on multiplication and division, using formal written methods to multiply and divide three-digit numbers by a one digit-number. We will also be learning how to calculate area. In the second half of the Spring Term, we will move on to working with fractions and decimals. The children will also be building speed and accuracy in recalling the multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12.

Our **Science** topic is 'Electricity'. We will be finding out how electricity travels around a circuit and will aim to construct a simple electrical circuit.
